Impact Sciences prepared a Program and Project EIR for California State University, Northridge's (CSUN) 30-year Master Plan, Envision 2005. Prepared by the Architecture, Planning

and Engineering firm of AC Martin Partners, the Master Plan is a comprehensive physical planning framework for the 353-acre San Fernando Valley campus, one of the largest in the CSU system. Intended to enable the University to accommodate growing enrollment and the broadening range of programs offered on the campus, the Master Plan addresses the expansion of academic and administrative facilities; enhancement of campus open space; expansion of student housing and dining facilities; development of faculty and staff

housing; improved vehicle and pedestrian access and circulation; new parking facilities; and upgrades of campus utilities. The EIR evaluated the comprehensive Master Plan as well as a number of proposed near-term Master Plan projects. Major issues included traffic and circulation, parking, housing, and a range of aesthetic issues, including balancing increased campus development with retention of open space and the creation of an attractive, distinct campus identity along the community interface.
